ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES OF THE MAY 2006 SC MEETING

Conclusions of the 1st ReSPA Steering Committee:

1. The Commission undertakes to:

- a) To distribute for consultation to all the members of the Steering Committee the Draft Terms of reference/Guidelines, by the end of May 2006.
- b) To distribute for consultation the Draft Rules of Procedure of the Steering Committee, by the mid-June 2006.
- c) To distribute a time line for follow-up actions, by mid June 2006.

2. The Members of the Steering Committee undertake to provide, by the end of May 2006 at the latest, their comments/input on the proposed action plan together with a needs assessment analysis for their respective country as well as with their proposals on the exchange of best practice experience, by identifying their field of expertise."
