The Networking Programme

ReSPA is establishing and maintaining a number of networks of Public administration representatives from the Western Balkans, working in the same thematic area. These networks serve as permanent instruments of sharing knowledge, experience and best practices bringing to ReSPA the dimension of the regional Hub for Public administration improvement and EU Integration and intelligence sharing with other organizations, programs and projects;

ReSPA networking events create opportunities for participants to compare and share lessons learned, and develop some replicable and transferable solutions. These events serve also a tool for exchange, for development of improved programmes or best practices, shared problem solving, provide

opportunities for collaboration among public administration practitioners (individuals and organizations) and generate ideas that promote greater leadership and innovative solutions.

These events are striving towards quality services. For this purpose networking events are organized both at ReSPA premises in the institutions and countries that offer the most up-to-date and required know-how on related issues.

On average these Networking events are organised twice per year as a two day event and are focused on practical – problem solving issues, but also encompassing strategic dimension with sometimes close relation to the decision making aspects.

ReSPA Networks

Community of Practitioners on HRM issues (CoP)

ReSPA has inherited the network on establishment and maintenance of Community of Practitioners on HRM issues from UNDP RC PAR, and is responsible for the overall management of this network. In addition it has intensified the frequency of the meetings of the CoP members (Conferences, Regional meetings, Workshops, Brainstorm sessions, Publications, etc). This network is aims at facilitating the process of mutual learning between its members in the scope of enhancing the public administration reforms in domain of HRM and HRD



EU Integration Network - heads of European Integration offices and their deputies

The EU Integration network is established at the regional level dedicated to the valuable topic of the European Integration, and is perceived as a platform that brings together the most important and most relevant stakeholders of the Western Balkan countries dealing with various aspects of the respective EUI thematic area.



eGovernment Network (Senior officials for e-government or e-services)

The rationale for the regional network of senior e-Government practitioners is based on the role it plays in the process of developing a more efficient, effective and accountable public administration by the support of the eGOVERNMENT in all related aspects (G2G – Government to Government, G2C – Government to Citizen, G2B – Government to Business). This will serve the Governmental institutions, the citizens and businesses better for less money, and will operate with transparent and open procedures. The network is focusing on the current eGOVERNMENT trends in EU, future development tendencies of eGOVERNMENT, identification of the capacity building activities related to networking and the presentations on state of the art on eGOVERNMENT in each country of the Western Balkans.

CoG – Secretary Generals Network

Secretary General's network seeks to support and strengthen the communication of the Western Balkan Governments upon the common issues in relation to national and regional policies, programmes and politics, also taking into consideration the aspect of EU integration process. The main aim of this network is to provide further support to regional network of Secretary Generals and their deputies

Network on Ethics and Integrity in the PA (Anticorruption)

This network has been established to support the process of establishment of accountable, transparent, effective, efficient and citizens' oriented Public Administration and Good Governance. This network provides the communication platform and exchange of know-how of the most important institutions dealing with anticorruption measures in the Western Balkans.



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
