The conference "From Insight to Action: Co-Creating Leadership for Public Administration" is jointly organised by the Croatian National School of Public Administration (NSPA) and the Regional School of Public Administration (ReSPA). The conference builds directly on the outcomes of the December 2024 Leadership Conference "Empowering Leaders: Advancing Leadership Excellence in the Western Balkans." That milestone event brought together senior public administration leaders, regional institutions, and international partners, and concluded with a clear mandate: to accelerate the design and delivery of impactful leadership training while fostering stronger regional cooperation and knowledge-sharing.

The 2025 conference is designed to deepen this mission and move from strategic discussion to practical implementation. It introduces innovative approaches such as the new NSPA learning concept "From Insight to Action" and the "Beyond Classroom Learning" initiative. Together, these innovations emphasize that leadership development does not end in formal training rooms; instead, it thrives in the workplace through practice, peer learning, mentoring ecosystems, and collaborative problem-solving.

This event therefore serves as both a reflection point and a launchpad. It brings together Western Balkans administrations, EU institutions, and international partners to:

- Showcase tangible results from the NSPA pilot programme and explore their implications for future leadership development models.
- Exchange good practices and success stories, highlighting competency-based frameworks, agile training formats, and digital leadership approaches.
- Jointly design a Regional Leadership Programme, drawing on collective insights and ensuring it reflects local contexts while meeting regional priorities.
- Launch a Community of Learning platform that will sustain collaboration, provide ongoing peer support, and enable continuous innovation after the event.

By positioning leadership as both a capacity and a culture, this conference underlines a shared ambition: to equip public administrations with leaders who can not only manage change but actively shape it.

The outcomes of these two days will directly inform the creation of a regional roadmap for 2026 and beyond, ensuring that leadership excellence translates into concrete improvements in governance, integration, and public service delivery across the Western Balkans.
