Capacity-building program in the area of Digital Transformation

The goal of the capacity development activity of ReSPA and SNA in the area of *Digital Transformation* is to add the new to the existing knowledge of senior civil servants working in different areas of the Digital Transformation pertaining to the **significance and impact of public policies for strengthening the capacity of public administrations for their digital transformation**.

Two capacity-building events will be used to increase the level of information on one side and on the other side for getting new knowledge with in-depth insights related to public policies in the area of digital transformation.

This capacity-building activity will have the following segments:

- 1. two days of training in Montenegro;
- 2. two days of training in Italy, followed by one and a half days of mobility visits of public servants from the Western Balkans to Italian institutions;
- 3. A joint online session with the participants of other streams of the programme.

The first capacity-building event will focus on the policies developed in the EU to accelerate Europe's digital transformation, building on progress toward a fully functioning Digital Single Market. The harmonization of national laws in EU is followed with the development of the digital-related regulatory framework. The second capacity-building event will be centered around the role, impact, and examples of policies in Italian public administration for enhancing the delivery of digitized services and for embracing modernization. The opportunity will be provided to get close insight and to get acquainted with the Italian-selected policies that relate to the design of digital services, accessibility, using cloud in public administration, reusing of software, using AI, use of digital signatures and electronic identification for trust services.

This two-module capacity development activity will bring together **18 public servants** of governmental institutions of senior level with experience in managerial roles in important ministries, institutions, or departments authorized to propose policies or participate in the key stages of developing digitized public services.

The first segment will be organized in Podgorica.
