Background

The legal alignment with the EU Acquis has been recognized as one of the priorities in the area of European integration of candidates and potential candidates for EU Membership. The Regional School of Public Administration (ReSPA) has organised a number of training activities and workshops dedicated to the topic of legal alignment. Some of them were generally covering the issue of transposition of the EU Acquis, and some were focused on some concrete chapters of the EU Acquis. Now, ReSPA will provide the training on legal alignment that will cover two negotiating chapters of the EU acquis Chapter 11 – Agriculture and Rural Development and Chapter 12 – Food Safety, Veterinary and Phytosanitary. The training will focus on few examples of legal transposition and preparation of the negotiating process for given chapters. The main legal concepts and principles covered by the two referred chapters will be explained and elaborated. The training will be interactive and based on real or simulated examples of the use of transposition techniques and methods. The training is expected to be more practically focused than theory oriented.

Target Group

The target audience is composed of civil servants from the European integration central coordinating institutions in charge of acquis transposition and other line ministries and administrative bodies in charge of transposition of negotiating chapters 11 and 12 or preparation of NPAA.

Methodology

The trainers will use power point presentations for all of the topics envisaged in the programme. This methodology will enable the participants to follow the intensive analysis as well as participate in the discussions for each block of presentations. Certain time will be allocated for interaction amongst trainers and participants. During the workshop, several practical exercises will be conducted to put into practice theory learnt before. This will enable both, trainers and participants, to learn from each other.

Training will be delivered by Ms Ružica Gelo and Ms Sanja Šeparović who have extensive experience in transposition, institutional building, NPAA development and accession negotiations related to the negotiating chapters 11 and 12.
