## Aim and Purpose of the Meeting

National Coordinators will be informed on various aspects of the implementation of activities during first months of 2018. On the agenda will be, also, detailed information on future planned activities by the end of 2018 which coincides with the end of the implementation of ongoing EC Grant.

The main objective of this meeting is to highlight the role of National Coordinators in the implementation of planned activities and especially in their role in the preparation of a Final report for EC Grant.
